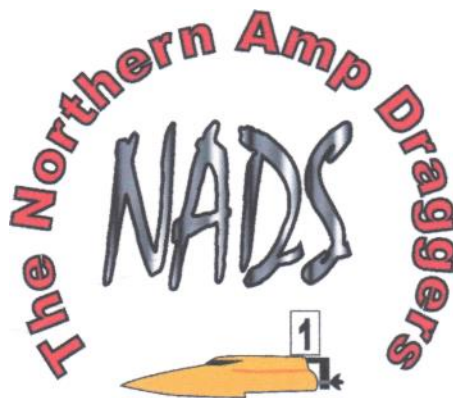

Change History –

Oct 2018 – A rule added that for the ‘Junior Open Class Championship’ we add the requirement that at least 2 juniors must compete for at least 3 meetings before the prize (Ian Phillips Cup) will be given

1 GENERAL

This document aims to only describe the rules for the junior championship(s). It is intended to be read in addition to the current NAD's rule book and where there is any discrepancy, the main rule book shall take precedence.

The qualifying age is defined in the main rule book.

There are two championships defined in this addendum.

1 "Junior Named Class Championship"

2 "Junior Open Class Championship"

These championships are to be run as part of normal club racing and are not separate junior races.

2 JUNIOR NAMED CLASS CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship is open to juniors racing in a Named Class that has 3 or more junior registered entrants, but only if the named class already has 6 or more registered adult entrants.

Points will be allocated in correspondence to the finish position. Points are allocated to the Entrants according to their placing ONLY in relation to other juniors, NOT seniors. The points are allocated as per the rule book.

Prizes will be awarded at each round to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place if there are sufficient junior entrants.

Points will be accumulated over the season and prizes awarded at the end of the season to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place if there are sufficient junior entrants.

3 JUNIOR OPEN CLASS CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship is open to juniors racing in classes other than the junior named class championship.

At the first race they enter in the season, the junior must nominate the class in which they wish to be judged. This class cannot be the junior named class, Mono2 or Hydro2.

Points will be allocated in correspondence to the finish position. Points are allocated to the Entrants according to their placing in relation to ALL racers, NOT just juniors. I.e. The points that they receive in the normal scores.

Points will be accumulated over the season for the nominated class and prizes awarded at the end of the season to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place if there are sufficient junior entrants.

At least 2 juniors must compete for at least 3 meetings before the prize will be given.

The first place will receive the "Ian Phillips Cup".
